



THE BIBLE TEACHING CONCERNING THE JUDGMENT

Basic Facts Concerning the Judgment

- 1) What does every person have to look forward to after death? Heb. 9:27
- 2) Will every person who has lived have to face the judgment? 2Cor. 5:10
- 3) How much of what we do will be brought into judgment? Eccles. 12:13,14
- 4) What will be the standard by which everyone will be measured in the judgment? James 2:12; John 12:48

The Timing of the Judgment

- 5) Has God appointed a specific day for the judgment to begin? Acts 17:31
- 6) Was the judgment yet to come in Paul's day? Acts 24:25
- 7) With whom will the judgment begin? 1 Peter 4:17

The Sanctuary and the Judgment

- 8) In the Scriptures, another term for the judgment is the "Cleansing of the Sanctuary." What was the name of the special article of dress the High Priest wore on his chest during the "Day of Judgment"? Ex. 28:15

Note: In the Sanctuary service that took place every day the common priests, (dressed in white) ministered in the courtyard and Holy Place. This provided forgiveness and a temporary atonement (or reconciliation) for the repentant individual. Once a year on the "Day of Atonement", the High Priest, wearing the "breast plate of judgment" went into the Most Holy Place to provide forgiveness and cleansing for the whole nation.

- 9) What did God say would happen to His people on that day? Leviticus 16:16,30
- 10) What happened to anyone who did not participate in the Day of Atonement service? Leviticus 23:28-30
- 11) When would this cleansing of the sanctuary begin? Daniel 8:14
- 12) We have learned previously that in Bible prophecy each day symbolizes one year. This would make this prophecy 2300 years long. (Ezekiel 4:6, Numbers 14:34)

- 13) When was Daniel told this prophecy would begin? Daniel 9:25
- 14) What did Daniel see being opened at the beginning of this judgment? Daniel 7:9-10
- 15) Who has promised to be our advocate in this judgment? 1 John 2:1-2

- 16) After the judgment is finished, what unalterable decree will God issue? Revelation 22:11

- 17) What will Jesus then do when every case has been decided? Revelation 22:12

- 18) If we have accepted Jesus as our Savior by allowing Him to forgive our past sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness, may we then look forward to Jesus' appearing? 1 John 2:28
