The Promise of His Coming

- 1) What promise did Jesus make to His followers in John 14:3?
I will come again, that where I am there you may be also.
- 2) What are the last recorded words of Jesus in the Bible? Rev. 22:20
Surely I come quickly

The Purpose of His Coming

- 3) Why did Jesus say He was returning? John 14:3
To receive us unto Himself
- 4) What did Matthew say His angels would do at His second coming? Matt. 24:31
Gather together the elect (God's people) from one end of heaven to the other.
- 5) What will the wicked do at His coming? Rev. 6:14-17
Hiding in the dens and rocks of the mountains, pleading for the rocks to fall on them.
- 6) What will happen to the wicked at this time? 2Thes. 2:8
Destroyed by the brightness of His coming

The Manner of His Coming

- 7) Some people teach that the Second Coming is a secret event, but the Bible teaches that it will be both **visible** and **audible**. How many people will see Him when He returns, and to what spectacular visual event is His coming likened? Rev. 1:7; Matt. 24:27 **Every eye shall see Him. Like lightning shining from one end of heaven to the other.**
- 8) What words does the Psalmist use to emphasize that the Second Coming will NOT take place silently? Psa. 50:3 **Our God shall come and NOT keep silent.**
- 9) What does the Bible tell us the world will **hear** at Christ's coming? Matt. 24:31; 1Thes. 4:16
A great sound of a trumpet. A shout and the voice of archangel.
- 10) What did Jesus warn His people to do if someone tells us Christ is "here, there, in the desert or in some secret chamber"? Matt. 24:23-26 **Believe it not. Go not forth.**

The Preparation of the People for Whom He is Coming

- 11) What will God's people be like when He appears, and what should those who have this hope be doing? 1John 3:1-3 **They be shall be like Him. They should purify themselves as He is pure.**

- 12) The Psalmist describes this glorious appearing in Psalms 50:3-6 How does this passage describe those He is coming for? Psalm 50:5 **Those who have made a covenant with God by sacrifice.**

- 13) Read the parable of the sheep and the goats in Matt. 25:31-46. What were those who eventually inherit the kingdom doing, which help to prepare them for His return? Matt. 25:33-36
Feeding the hungry. Giving drink to the thirsty. Clothing the naked. Visiting the sick. Coming to visit those who are in prison.
